

# ALLERTON STEPS TOWARD SUSTAINABILITY

The Visitors Center complex is now being heated with two wood fired boilers and supplemented by the original gas boiler. They currently heat the Visitors Center, Regency office building, park ops building, paint shop, wood shop and the new maintenance building. The majority of funding was provided by the Student Sustainability Committee.

- 2009- 2010 heating season - the first wood boiler was installed
- 2010-2011 heating season - the boiler from the diversified farm was installed in to the heating system
- 2011-2012 heating season - the new maintenance building was connected into the heating system.
