- 1. Visit the Call2Recycle website at http://www.call2recycle.org/ and join the free rechargeable battery recycling program.
- 2. Call2Recycle will follow up with a return phone call to you. When you receive this call, please provide them with the University of Illinois's Parent ID #78151.
- 3. Call2Recycle will send the collection boxes with UPS shipping labels directly to your building.
- 4. Notify Environmental Compliance at <u>bliggett@illinois.edu</u> that you have initiated the program and where within your building the recycling receptacle is located.
- 5. When a box is full of individually bagged rechargeable batteries, check to ensure that only acceptable batteries are in the box.
- 6. Write down the box's UPS tracking number and then place the full box at a UPS pickup location. UPS will pick the box up free of charge at the time of their next scheduled delivery.
- 7. UPS will ship the full box of batteries to a metal reclamation center for processing.
- 8. Call2Recycle will automatically send you new empty boxes with UPS shipping labels.
- Visit the UPS website at <u>http://www.ups.com/</u> to save the shipping documents and track the shipments in an Excel spreadsheet. Forward the spreadsheet to Environmental Compliance at <u>bliggett@illinois.edu</u> on a quarterly basis.
