In connection with the application for funding that the Illinois Sustainable Technology Center (ISTC) has submitted to the Student Sustainability Committee, Dining services at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign pledges their support for the nitrile glove recycling project.

As part of our Housing sustainability initiative, Dining Services strives to improve and expand our recycling efforts.
