For context, I founded a national graduate leadership program at the American Association for the Advancement of Science and am a frequent speaker at student events on science policy and career preparation. I am also a member of the National Academy of Science Engineering and Medicine Committee on "Revitalizing STEM graduate education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century."

The SPG leaders invited me to participate in their Science Policy Workshop in September 2017. I also discussed planning with the lead organizers, Libby Haywood, Ryan Rooney, and Zachary Gordan, in the months prior to the event. I was blown away by their professionalism, organization, and especially their strategic vision. They worked backward from clearly defined outcomes to determine the content and speakers for each session. I was particularly impressed that they focused on all of the pillars of sustainability – environmental, economic, and social – and helped participants consider trade-offs among them.

I have rarely seen such strategic vision and planning even among more senior leaders and established organizations. They also treated me like a VIP, attending to every detail and ensuring that I had the information I needed for smooth travel and presentation.

They are passionate about making a positive contribution to the university and the world. I have a feeling that they will continue to make you and UIUC very proud.
