The Student Sustainability Committee (SSC) seeks new Faculty Member-Advisors for the 2018-2019 academic year. SSC is a group of 12 students dedicated to improving sustainability at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. With the help of 10 faculty and staff that serve as member-advisors, SSC meets to review and select projects that receive funding from two student fees, the Sustainable Campus Environment Fee and the Cleaner Energy Technologies Fee. Both of these student fees bring in over \$1.1 million annually, which is one of the largest sustainability funds of its kind in the United States.

Advisors can expect to commit one-hour per week to SSC, including:

- Attending a biweekly one-hour meeting.
- Attending two three-hour voting meetings per semester.
- Providing students with insight & expertise from your professional & research experience.
