Meanwhile we should have further discussion on the procedures to update the CAM policy (i.e., to purchase 30% + post-consumer recycled content paper).
Morgan Johnston (F&S)	F&S supports this recommendation.
Robyn Deterding (Student Affairs)	On behalf of Student Affairs, I support this recommendation
Matthew Tomaszewski (Provost's Office)	I support this recommendation.
Gary Kling (Academic Senate)	The implementation of this recommendation should be relatively easy if we have administrative buy-in. This recommendation should help to accomplish that.
Joseph Edwards (Student Sustainability Leadership Council)	I support this proposal. Recycled paper should be the norm on our campus and this program will help make that happen.
Sean Reeder (OBFS)	I'm generally supportive of this, though also wonder how effective a campaign to educate the purchasing staff for each department on increasing use of recycled paper.
