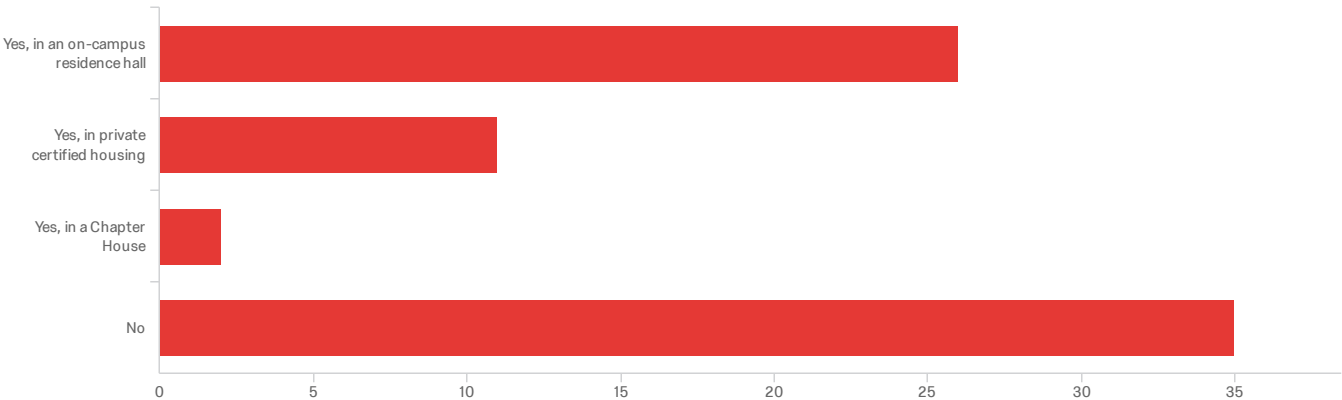

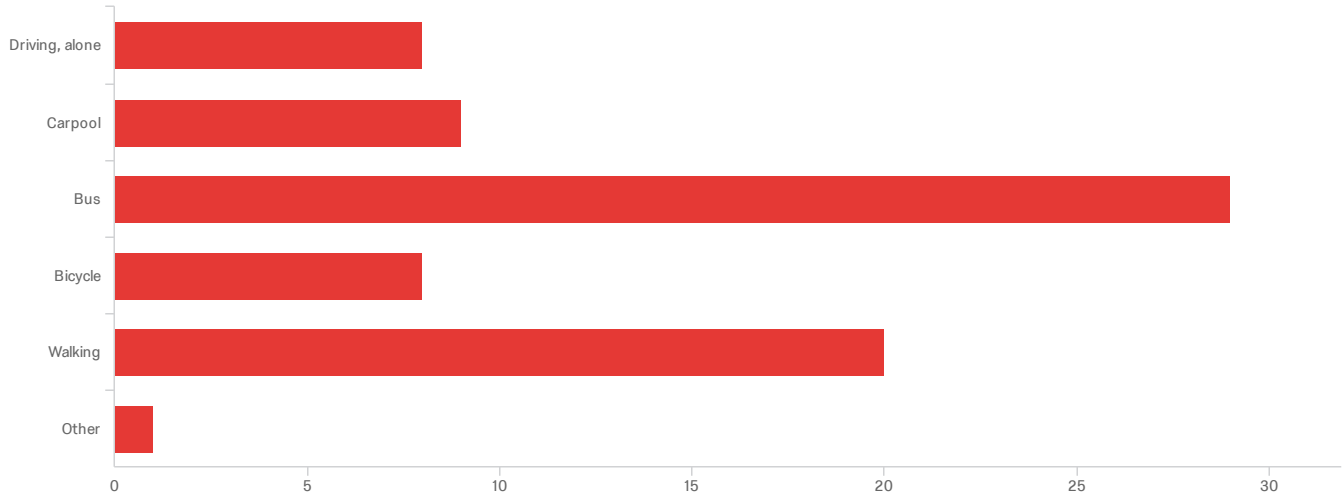

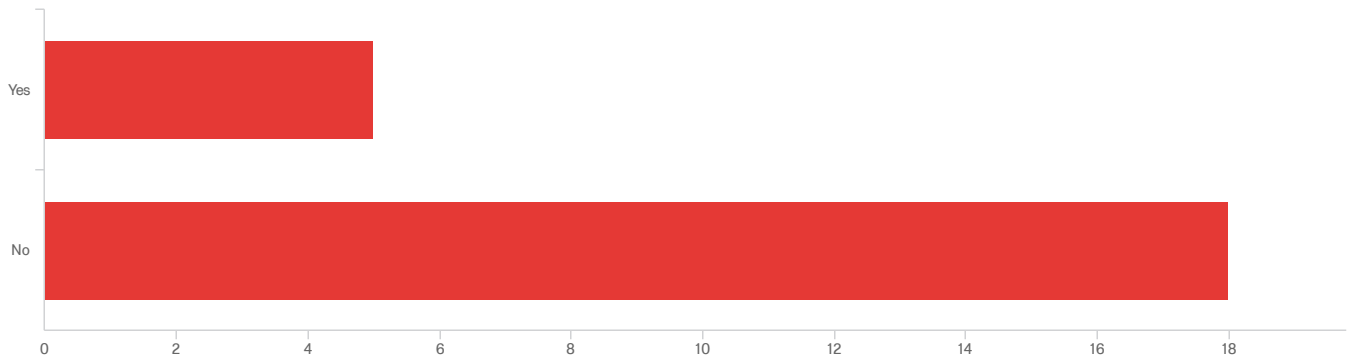

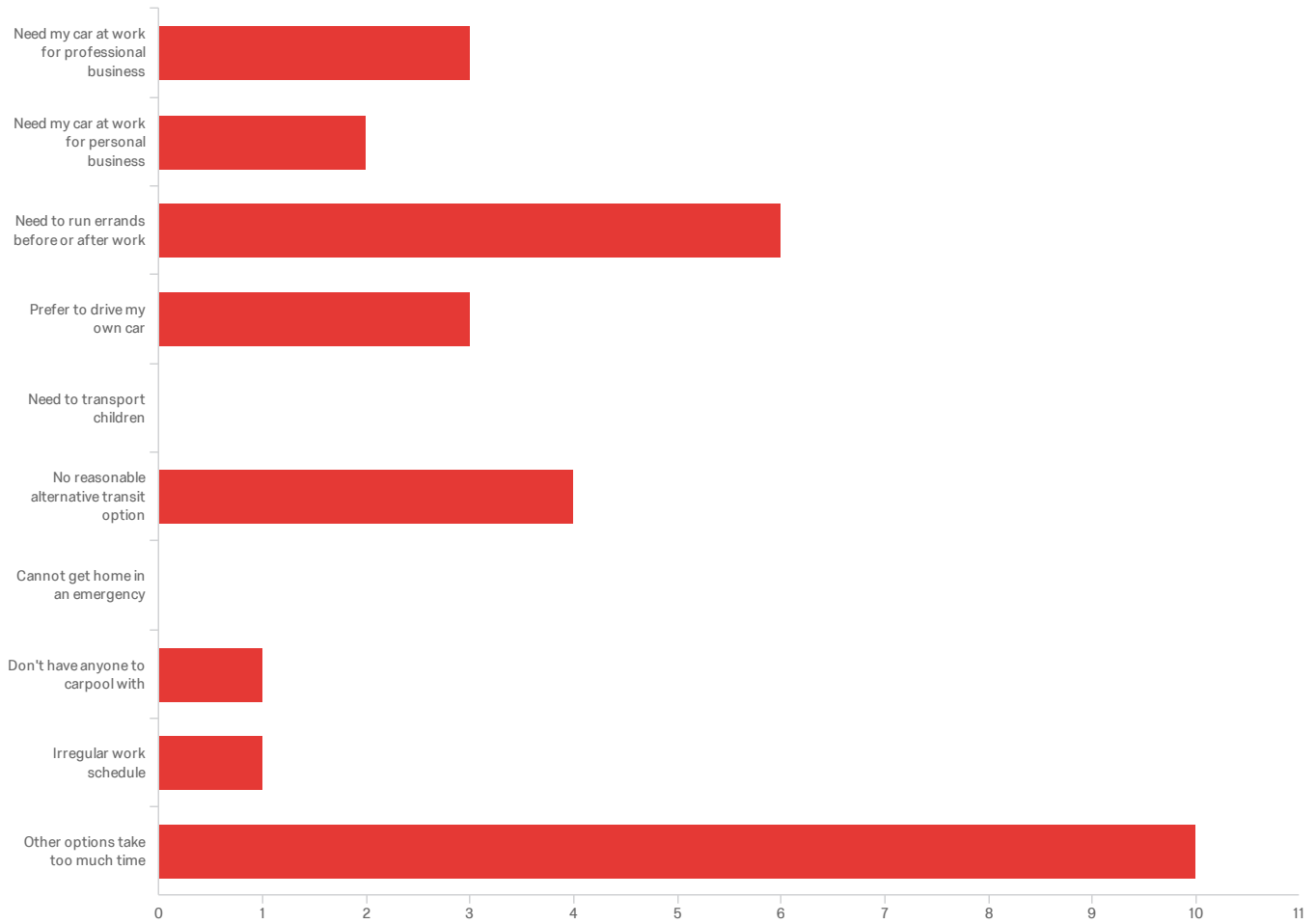

for all CUMTD routes?



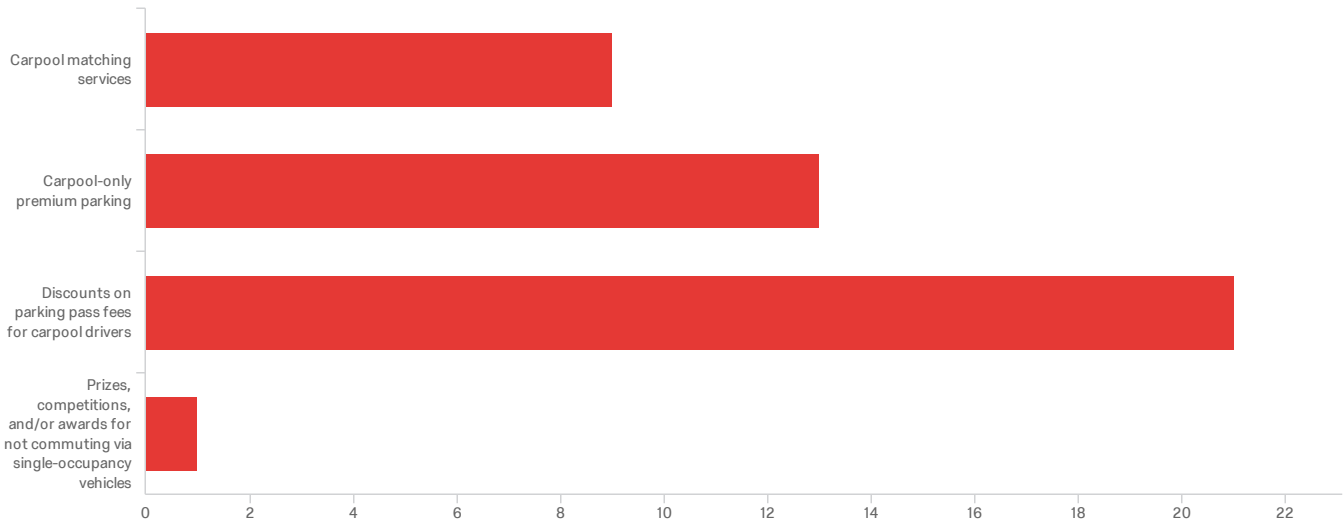

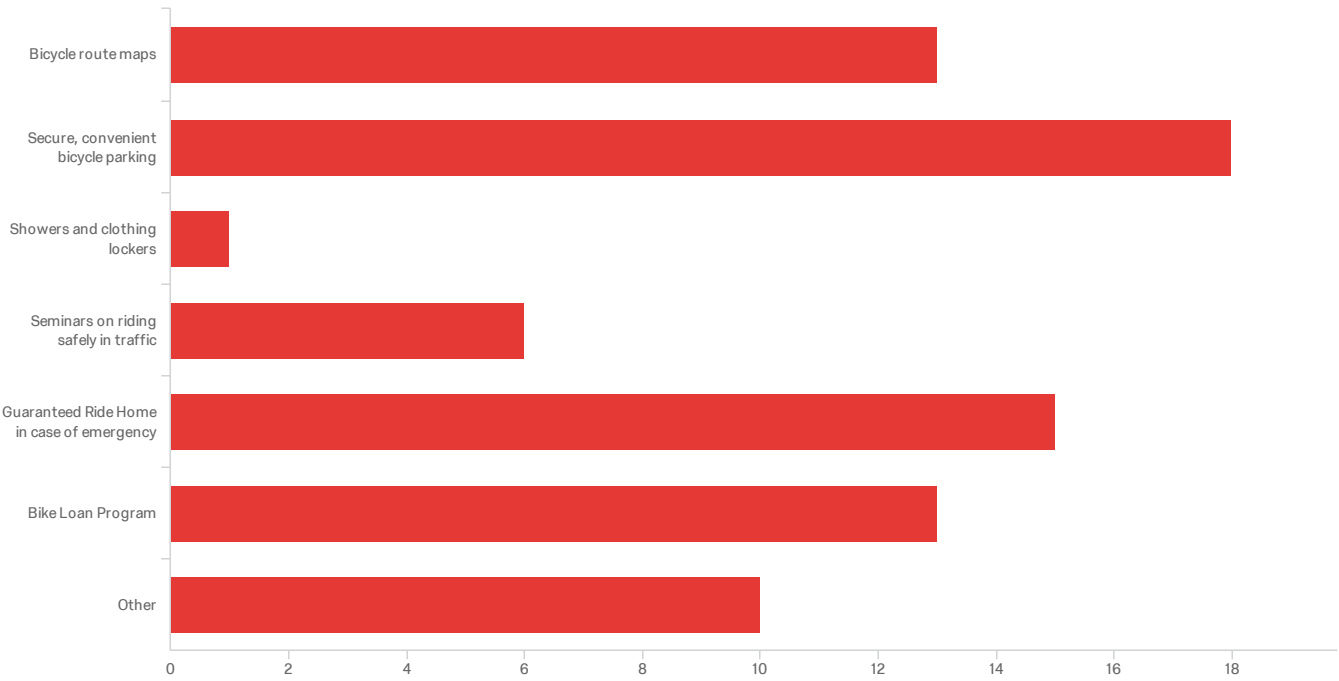

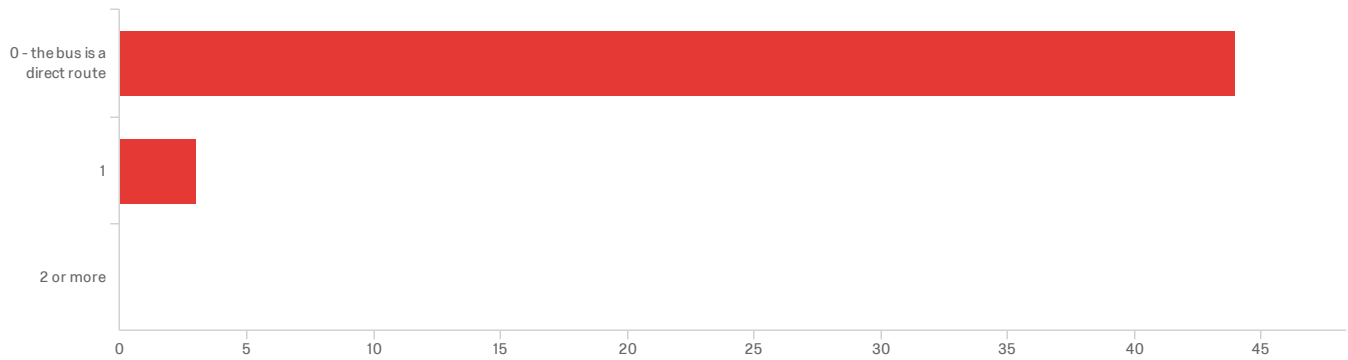

## Q24 - If you take the bus to campus, how many times do you have to transfer lines?

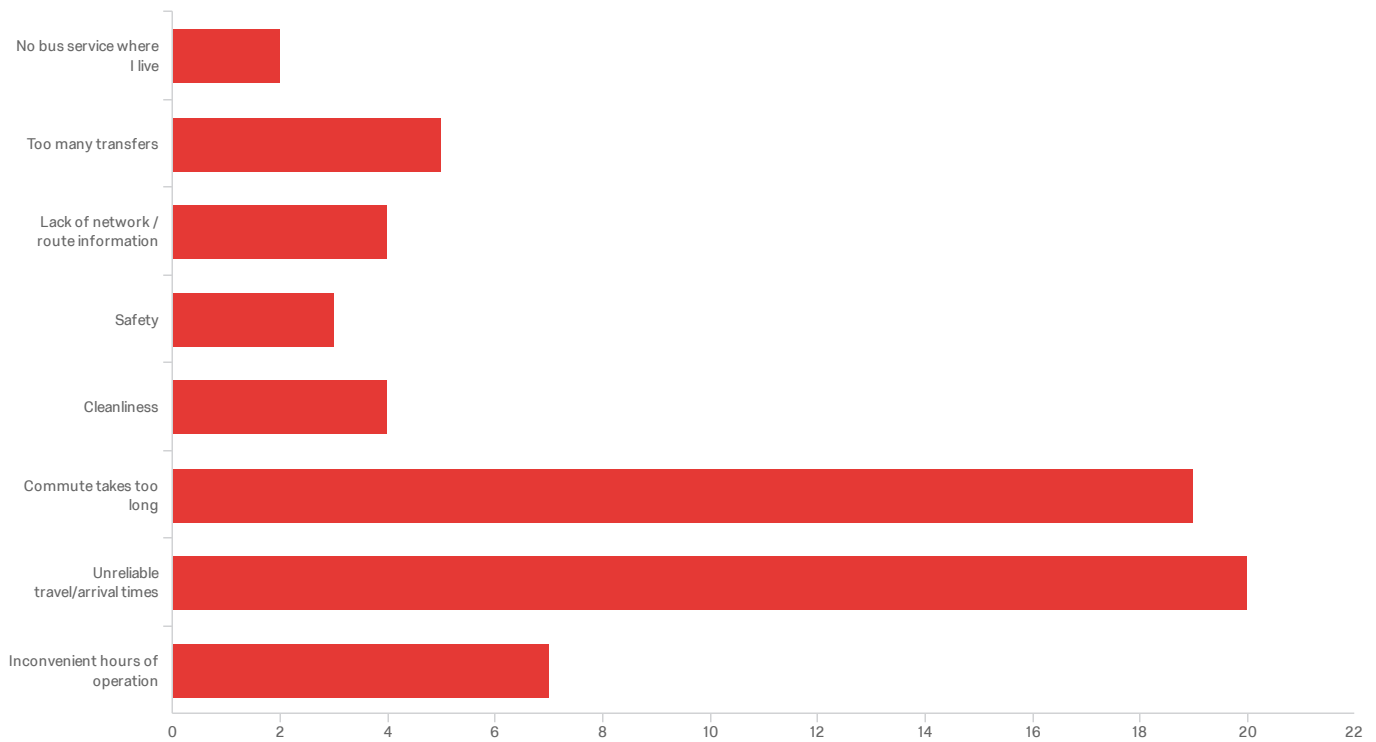

I already stated my concern about biking through foot traffic, but to further explain, the biggest complaint about biking on campus I hear from both bikers and walkers is that it feels unsafe. There should be more knowledge on what paths are bike paths and what paths are walking paths, and more paths should be created/existing paths should be re-done to make this very clear and allow for bikers and walkers to go about their routes separately.

It's very inconvenient that major routes, like the 22Illini and 13Silver, have such limited schedules on the weekends. I still have a lot of college-related activities on weekends and depend on them for transportations and the limited routes suck.

I've never been taught how to use the bus and I've heard a lot of conflicting information regarding how it works. As such, I'm a sophomore and still have never been on it to this day.

I'm a student who works in research park, there is only one bus route that goes through the area. This was fine when I lived in Champaign, but I moved to Urbana which forces me to drive to work even though I'd rather not. It's just transferring and unreliable times make it hard to take the bus to and from work to the classes I need to get to.

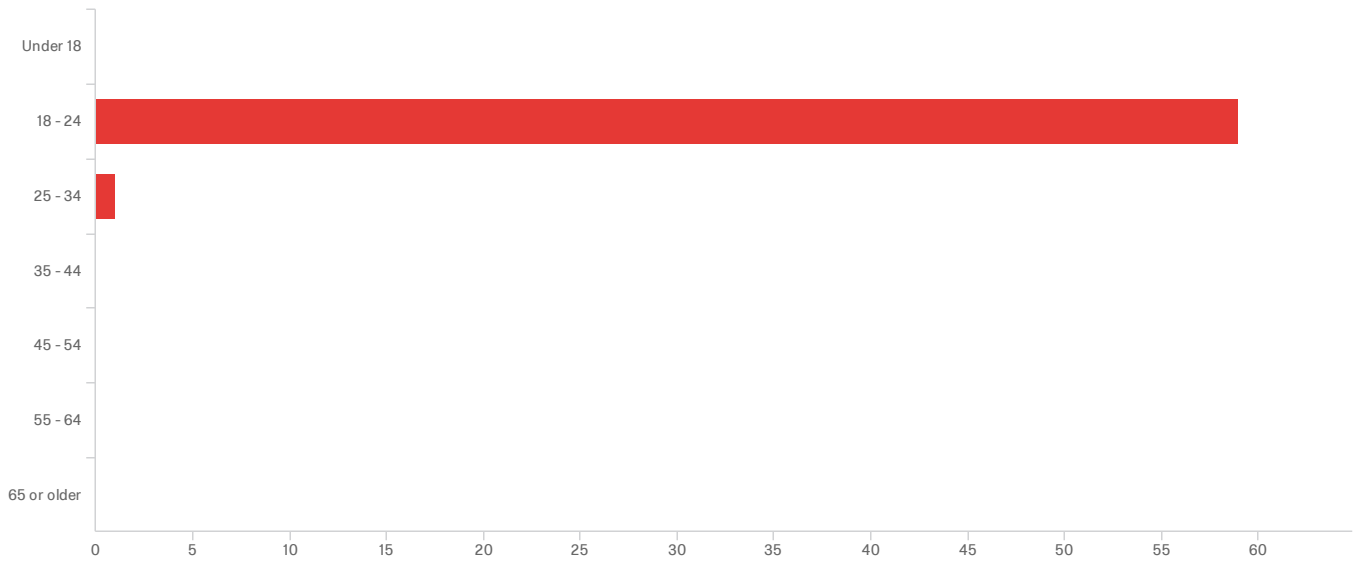

## Q8 - How old are you?

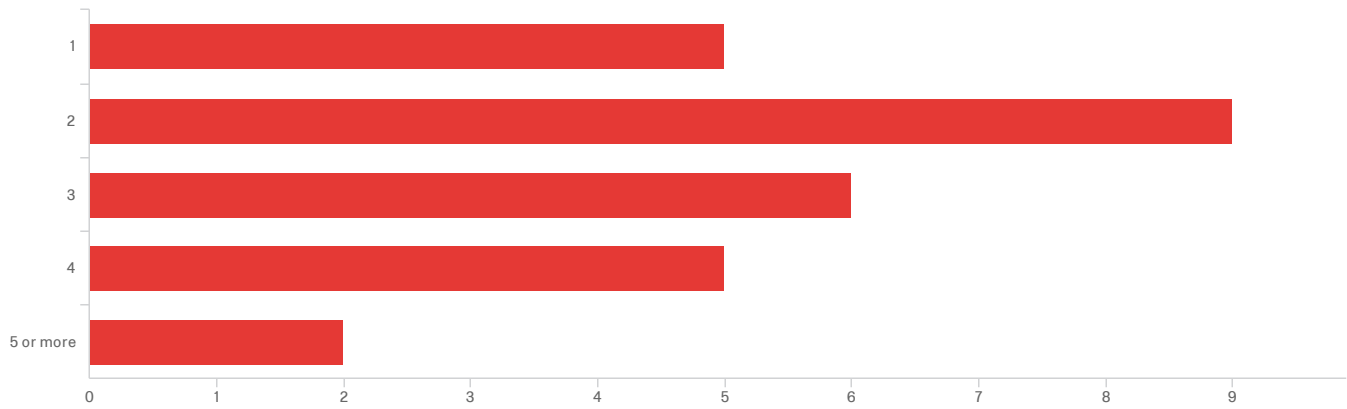

## Q9 - Counting yourself, how many people live in your household?

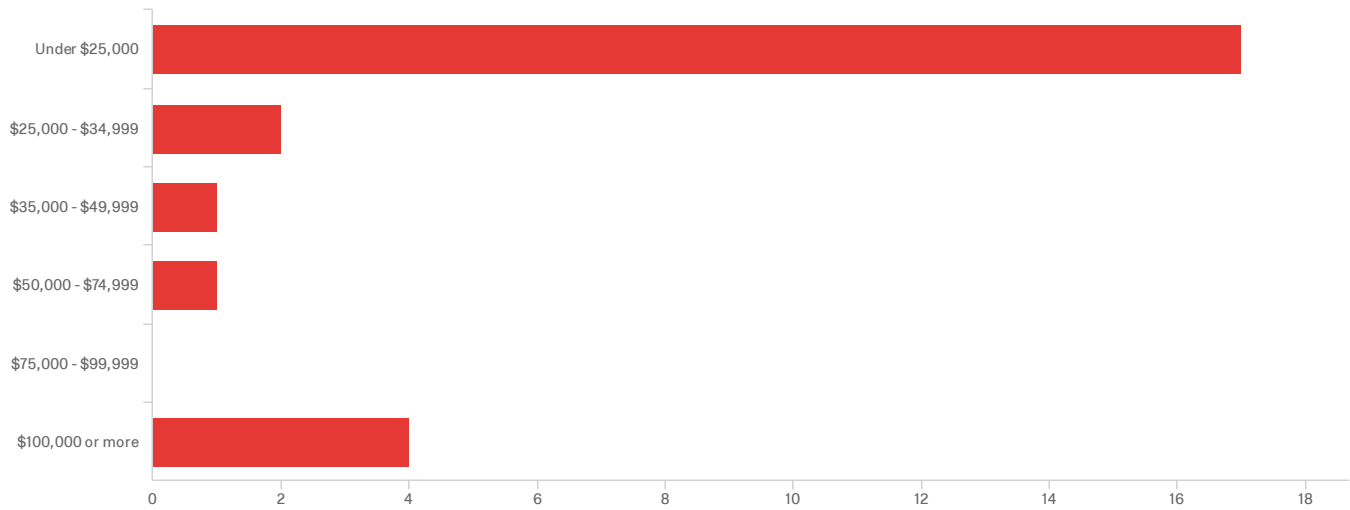
