Specific Actions/Policy Recommended (a few sentences):

PWR kindly requests the addition of a member from the Student Housing Department to the PWR SWATeam. Ideally, this person would be a director or associate director so that planning and initiatives will receive attention at the highest level and be disseminated effectively.

Rationale for Recommendation (a few sentences):

As we assess levels of Waste and opportunities for waste reduction in accordance with the objectives of PWR, advice from someone with authority in Student Housing will be helpful. An expert on the processes and protocols of residential and dining halls will assist in designing and implementing new initiatives. This is important because housing has the highest population density on campus, is the best way to reach a large number of students, and already has the best campus recycling program, so they could help educate the rest of campus on proper methods and programs.

The PWR SWATeam greatly benefited from having representatives from Facilities and Services (Macie Sinn) and Purchasing (Aaron Finder) on the Team this year.
