We wish to reallocate funds originally planned for a speaker and intern wages to secure 25 copies of Braiding Sweetgrass by Robin Wall Kimmerer, stickers to be used as giveaways at events, and sustainable reusable grocery bags and other items to be used as prizes during the trivia event.

In addition to the planned speakers for the Ecofeminism Summit, we hope to host two additional events, a book club featuring Braiding Sweetgrass and an Ecofeminism Trivia Night in collaboration with the Illini Union's Trivia Tuesdays program in the Courtyard Café. The Trivia Tuesdays events will require the WRC to provide 12 prizes for the winners of the trivia contest.

During our Welcome Back event, the WRC gave away sustainable reusable grocery bags and found that they were more popular than we had imagined. Students continue to come back to the WRC in hopes of receiving a bag. Because of the popularity of the item and its function as a reusable item meant to reduce waste, we believe that offering an Ecofeminism version of this bag will encourage attendance at events and promote sustainable practices amongst students.

In regards to the book club, we would like to include a book club featuring Braiding Sweetgrass by Robin Wall Kimmerer. The Women's Resources Center will provide students who register for the book club with a free copy of the text. This scope change is to account for the purchase of the texts. The original application that was submitted did not include a book club, however, by hosting a book club we can further engage students in the critical research surrounding indigenous wisdom, social justice, and environmental justice.
